ZBTB16/CCP11 FISH Probe Kit

Introduction


The ZBTB16/CCP11 FISH Probe Kit is designed to detect the human ZBTB16 gene located on chromosome band 11q23.2, along with the number of chromosome 11 copies per cell. Rearrangements and abnormal expression of the ZBTB16 gene - also known as PLZF or ZNF145 - have been reported in acute promyelocytic leukemia and other neoplasias.

Intended Use

To measure the copy number of the human ZBTB16 gene located on chromosome band

Probe Design



LSP ZBTB16 FISH Probe covers a chromosomal region which includes the entire ZBTB16 gene. CCP11 FISH Probe, derived from chromosome 11-specific alpha satellite DNA, is designed to serve as a control to determine the number of chromosome 11 copies per cell.
